Meghan 3421 Trails End, experiencing erosion issues as the dig gets closer to their property. Jerri McCullum 3450 Trails End, contact OSHA for violations.

10. Discussion and possible action on Ordinance 2025-03, road weight limits.

Secretary LaMaster read the heading, definitions, and fines section for the Board of Aldermen. There was concern about the weight limit set at 12,000 pounds as it pertained to all vehicles. Morrow queried if we had engineering data for the roads. Fowler suggested using public records to find road weight limits for both 803 (currently Cross Timber) and 803c (currently Trails End). Discussion of a truck route ordinance that would address the number of axels.


