4. **Discussion and possible action on road repair to Cross Timber Road edges and potholes.**

Mayor pro-tem Ball asked the infrastructure committee to provide information on the quotes and committee recommendations. Chairman Tarver yielded to committee member Russell Broome, 3350 Cross Timber Road, to discuss. The committee chose Reynolds to complete road work on edges from the FM 731 stop sign to the town property, including a complete overlay of the curve near town property. This bid includes materials and is \$31,307. The company is vetted by Johnson County and knows the necessary code to complete the job professionally.

Paige Linendoll, 7000 Weatherby, will the poles come down? Answered by Broome, yes. Alderman Edwards wanted to know if it included the low water crossing. No it does not. Alderman Sumien concerned that using the \$31K for these repairs will diminish the funds needed to complete the full repair when the trucks are done. Kimberli Broome, 3350 Cross timber Road, stated she was working on a grant to obtain funds for the Cross Timber repairs. Alderman Edwards agrees with Alderman Sumien, yet believes it is an investment that is needed. Sarah Elliott, Cross Timber, wanted to know if they will rip out this work during the complete repair. Russell Broome did not believe they would. Alderman Sumien queried if it was a mistake to do the repairs at this time. Sarah Elliott, 3151 Cross Timber, stated the roads are in such disrepair if she were to have an accident because of the roads she would sue the town. Charlene Williams, 2812 Cross Timber, agrees that the road repairs should be done. Kimberli Broome, 3350 Cross Timber, stated the road would only be 20' wide and will cap the edges to prevent further deterioration.
