

8. Committee Reports:**a. Capital Improvements Committee**

Chairperson Sisson stated the committee is putting together a complete package to present to the board for town property improvements, including ADA railings, ADA parking, awning, ceiling fans, etc.

b. Infrastructure Committee –

Chairperson Tarver identified there had been a setback on repairs for Cross Timber Road and that the committee would like to postpone the approved road work. Kimberli Broome, 3350 Cross Timber Road, stated if Trails End Road repairs were to occur as a separate event there would be an additional \$14K charge for equipment set-up. In the meantime, Trophy Materials will pellet top Trails End Road, and they will also be trimming trees on Cross Timber Road with no charge to the town. Ralph Ollman, 3301 Trails End Road, does this repair include the area on the south of the road damaged by trucks pulling over? Kimberli Broome replied yes, and then Mr Ollman asked why trucks can't radio each other to avoid pulling off the road. Mayor Meier stated not all trucks have CB radios. Jim Fowler, 3375 Trails End Road, stated they seem to communicate with each other when the sheriff is in the area.

9. Discussion and possible action to approve Budget for FY 2025-2026 and Ordinance #2025-04.

11. Discussion and possible action on public easement for Trails End Road.

Mayor Meier stated we did not receive a response from the attorney in time for the meeting. The mayor clarified that County Clerk have the 1991 map and the Central Appraisal District and 911 Coordinator have the later maps identifying annexed areas. Therefore there are still questions about public and private roads and we will wait for the legal opinion from the lawyer.


